Contract and Planning Support for BIM in Canada

The successful adoption of BIM is not merely a matter of using the right technology but also requires preparation and agreement between construction project stakeholders. Planning for BIM use can be a major undertaking and the results need to be captured in the project contract and protocol. Jointly founded in 2010 by national construction sector organizations (including CSC), the Institute for BIM in Canada (IBC) focuses on providing industry with the resources to productively apply BIM to their work. Attendees will be introduced to IBC and learn about the recently released BIM Contract Appendix and Project Execution Planning (PxP) Toolkits, their legal intent and how they are designed to work together to support BIM effective adoption in the Canadian Construction Sector.

Speaker bio

John Dickinson, Ph.D., P. Eng., works to support the migration of the Construction Sector to more integrated and digitally based processes and practices as a consulting partner and president of Advanced BIM Solutions. His expertise is built upon a Doctorate in Mechanical Engineering, a Master's in Computer Science and his experiences from working for 13 years at the National Research Council of Canada in the Manufacturing and Construction sectors on information use in the product design and the production cycle. In the last 4 years John has given almost 20 public and professional presentations on BIM and represented Canada at International BIM Standards meetings.

For this presentation John is representing the Institute for BIM in Canada (IBC) where he has acted as the Chair for the Technical Advisory Committee for several years. IBC is a joint national organization formed in 2010 by ACEC, CCA, CSC, DCC, DND, CSC, and RAIC to foster a national, industry based approach to BIM adoption in the construction sector.
