“IDP: How to do it wrong” session will take the audience throughout the wonderful world of Integrated Project Delivery. The session will touch mainly on the interactions (or lack thereof) of trying to implement IPD on a project – mainly from the Design-Build contractor’s viewpoint. We will review several different approaches to showcase the fun and follies that a team would find themselves in. We will explore the relationships among the project team members: owner, architect, consultants, sub-trades and suppliers – and going over the actual and perceived responsibilities of what IPD means (or doesn’t mean) to each.

Cam Munro’s almost 30-year diverse career has had a strong focus in Integrated Project Delivery and he has accumulated vast experience and knowledge in a wide range of markets, products and environments. Cam is currently the Innovative Construction Manager for Clark Builders corporately, where he oversees all of the IPD / BIM requirements and sustainable initiatives for the company’s projects. He leads the in-house BIM Technical team to promote and utilize BIM as an effective construction evolution.
