The P3 Panel discussion will be an informative session that will provide a brief overview of what P3s are, how they work, and why they are used. The panelists have both been actively involved in the Alberta Schools Alternative Procurement (ASAP) model of delivering schools in a P3 environment and will provide their perspectives on the process from an Owner's and Contractor's point of view. Lessons learned will be part of the discussion as well as some crystal ball gazing as to the future of P3s, including the opportunities and challenges that lie ahead. The session is intended to be interactive with ample opportunity for audience participation and questions.

David Clinckett

David graduated with a degree in Civil Engineering in 1977 from the University of Waterloo. He first worked for a national construction firm in Winnipeg for two years, then moved to Calgary and worked for two engineering design firms in the Oil and Gas sector for seven years. David joined the Calgary Roman Catholic School District in 1987 overseeing the Construction Department. Over the last 26 years he has been involved in the construction of over 35 schools, one downtown office building and countless additions and modernization. His responsibilities include consultation with the City and Developers in the location and acquisition of the land for future school sites at the Area Structure Plan Stage, working with the Provincial government in obtaining funding for the projects, hiring consultants, overseeing of the design, construction and commissioning of the schools, and liaising between the educators and design professionals.

Kees Cusveller

Kees is currently the VP of Business Development and Preconstruction Services for the Graham Group of Companies, a major North American construction contractor. He has been involved in a wide variety of projects and contract types including heading up the \$850 million ASAP 1 and 2 School Programs consisting of 28 schools in a P3 arrangement for the Province of Alberta.

Kees has an MBA from the University of Calgary, a B. Comm. from the University of Alberta, and a Construction Engineering Technology Diploma from NAIT in Edmonton. He is currently on the Board and Executive of the Canadian Construction Association and is past Chair of the Alberta Construction Association, the Calgary Construction Association and Calgary General Contractors Association. Kees has taught a construction costing course through the University of Calgary's Faculty of Extension and is an advisor to SAIT on their Bachelor of Science in Construction Project Management program. He is a regular speaker on construction related topics and has been active in open discussions with both the public and private sector about the role of Public Private Partnerships in government construction programs.
