- ◆ The Certified Construction Contract Administrator (CCCA) designation provides professional recognition to individuals who administer construction contracts on a construction project to follow the requirements of a construction contract.
- ◆ In particular, an individual with this designation performs quality work in accordance with accepted, recommended standards. A CCCA uses skill and shows good judgment on issues, providing instructions that are current, clear, concise, thorough, fair and enforceable based on merit, in a concise and complete manner.
- ◆ What makes a CCCA valuable to an organization is the Code of Conduct that governs a CCCA's actions, ensuring integrity and unbiased representation.
