Architects are experimenting ways to improve design processes to create environments that are accessible and welcoming to all. Dr. Henry Tsang has been investigating the issue of EDI in architecture both in his academic research and design works, particularly with underserved ethnic, indigenous and rural communities in the Canadian context, and he will be presenting case studies that demonstrate creative solutions in achieving EDI in architecture.
