The Value of a Lunch and Learn

It is not uncommon for an architectural firm to see one lunch and learn a month, providing education on a topic which they feel will enhance product or building science knowledge to a majority of their employees. There are a number of different types of lunch and learns offered not only to teach but to also provide core



credits required to maintain designations from different associations.

Some lunch and learns touch on "Back to the Basics" principles for firms that feel they might be a little rusty on. Topics such as flashing, roofing/waterproofing and air and vapour barrier detailing are just a few that are good to have discussed at least once a year to ensure that these key building science principles are being dealt with correctly before the drawings are at the construction site.

Hot topics in the industry also tend to draw the masses, as many try and stay on the same educational level during the transition period between knowledge and application on projects. Presentations dealing with building code changes, legal updates, CCDC contract updates, and new or innovative products are most commonly required at the conception stage but slowly dwindle as people become aware of their existence and decide if they might modify how the firm operates. One example of this dwindle could be BIM design.

I feel that there is a time and a place where a lunch and learn might be preferred over a face-to-face meeting. However, this decision needs to be made between the lunch and learn coordinator and the technical representative who is going to take on the expense of providing the lunch. In my opinion, there must be a balance of key influencers and individuals with a desire to learn, for a lunch and learn to be successful. Influencers can help instill the basic principles or core values that the presentation is trying to convey to the firm long after the presentation has concluded. Without this balance it may feel like the lunch is more important than the learn.


