Decoustics Plant Tour Report

Everyone at the Decoustics Plant Tour had a technical session that covered Specifications, Fire and Smoke testing, Acoustical testing and Indoor Air Quality (IAQ) Testing. Fire testing in Canada is governed by CAN/ ULCS102 and is conducted in the same Tunnel apparatus as ASTM E84. This 25-ft furnace chamber



measures flame spread and smoke development. In Canada, 3 identical panel assembly tests for each product is a National Building Code Requirement.

The Fire Test measures surface flame spread and smoke density calibrated to that of select grade red oak and fibercement board. The time to spread the flame along the entire length of the select grade red oak specimen is 51/2 minutes. A 24' (7.32m) long by 20" (508mm) wide panel is exposed to a controlled air flow and a flaming fire exposure for 10 minutes. The test is applicable to walls and ceilings.

It is conducted with the surface to be evaluated horizontally mounted with the exposed face down toward the ignition source. The purpose of this test method is to determine the relative burning behavior of the material by observing the flame spread along the specimen. Flame spread and smoke developed



index are reported but there is not necessarily a relationship between them.


Before the curling begins, there will be about 20 minutes of curling lessons given by the club's professional staff

THE TOPIC

Alex will be talking about the world, U.S. and Canadian economic outlooks, with special emphasis on construction activity levels here at home. Alex will also explore some favorite themes of his: impacts of the growing proportion of seniors aged 65-plus; the nation's three natural population groupings and shifts over time; and a concern that Canadians don't fully understand: what it will take to remain competitive in the global marketplace? Canada is swiftly transforming from the country of our forefathers into something quite different and it's best to understand the new reality.

Our Speaker: Mr. Alex Carrick

Alex Carrick did his undergraduate work at the University of Western Ontario (London, Ontario, Canada), and completed an M.A. in Economics at the University of Toronto. After the first year of a Doctorate while living at U of T's Massey College, the lure of the job market was too great and in 1972 Alex went to work for the Canadian Institute of Steel Construction (CISC).







The CISC is a trade association for structural steel fabricators in Canada. Mr. Carrick later became Secretary-Treasurer as well as Economist for the CISC.

Since 1985, Mr. Carrick has been Chief Economist with CanaData, the leading supplier of statistics and forecasting information for the Canadian construction industry. He is the closing speaker at the CanaData Annual Construction Industry Forecasts Conference, which just marked its 25th anniversary year.

Mr. Carrick compiles CanaData's Annual Construction Forecast and provides updates throughout the year in the CanaData Forecaster monthly newsletter and online at www.reedconstructiondata.com/market-insights. His work has become international in scope


