REGINA ANIMAL COMMUNITY CENTRE



A NumberTEN / 1080 collaboration, this project, set to open in summer 2023, is designed to highlight the bond between humans and animals and provides space for adoption, education, outreach and retail in addition to clinic, holding and cremation services. The building design creates a welcoming space for interaction, with distinct zones tailored to the functional needs of each service. The design is an efficient and cost-effective model of humane care and community invovlement with the health standards of a hospital, the educational aspects of a school, and the appeal of a community destination.

The interior theming creates a place for everyone to engage, learn, and interact with animals. Through playful interconnected geometry, the visual language used in the space graphically represents the relationship and bond between humans and their pets through interactive features, educational graphics, integrated signage and donor recognition. Pops of colour and large-scale imagery visulaly represents the joy felt when engaging with our four-legged friends.


