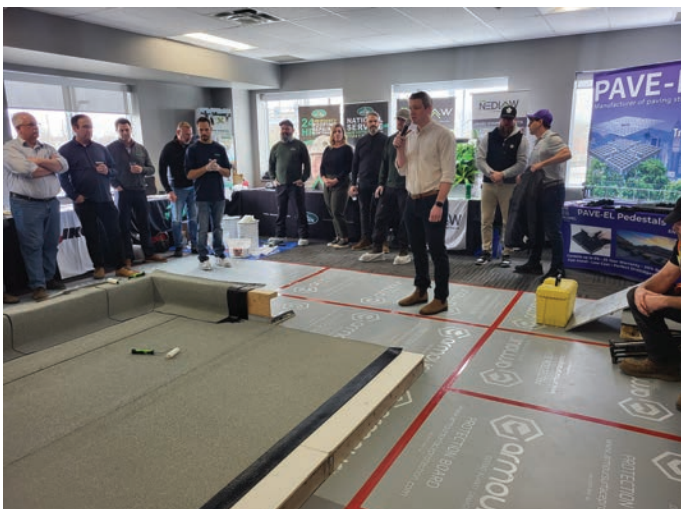


Why Become a Member?

The review of CCDC 30 – IPD – remains under review with an update version being circulated by additional comments. Seminars are being planned in 2024 to introduce new updated documents including CCDC 2MA, 4, 16, 18 & 20.

CSC Certification/Courses

The Education Certification Committee continues to provide oversight for TR, CCCA, CSP and RSW subcommittees. The PCD course continues to be included in 4 colleges across Canada.
