

Review of the Alberta Prompt Payment and Construction Lien Act and its upcoming amendments from a legal and practical perspective.



He has authored several works, notably playing a key role in the development of the National Energy Code of Canada for Buildings (NECB) and contributing volumes for both ASHRAE and BIM Canada publications. In addition, he occupies positions on the SAIT School of Construction Advisory Board, The Advanced Technology in Construction Executive, and the Standing Committee for Energy Efficiency at the National Research Council of Canada.

Construction BRIEFING GLOBAL CONSTRUCTION INSIGHTS - EVERY DAY



Bobcat expands North American product lineup with backhoe loader. by Mitchell Keller Deputy Editor, International Construction

Global farm and construction equipment manufacturer Bobcat Company is entering new product territory in North America with the launch of its B760 backhoe loader.

<u>According to Doosan</u>, Bobcat first introduced a backhoe loader in India in 2019, but the B760's availability – slated for either late this year or early 2025 – will be a first for the North American market. The machine comes with a standard-equipped extendable arm that provides up to 8 in (20cm) of additional dig-depth compared to other units of the same size, said Bobcat.

It has a lift capacity more than 2,200 lbs (998kg) at full reach, an 18-ft-5-in (2.6m) digging-depth, and offers nearly 180-degrees of backhoe swing.


