ABOUT THE PROJECT

The building is intended to house maintenance equipment, a small office, and staff amenity space. The building features two main masses; office and shop. The building uses wood construction in a variety of different assemblies.

The project was designed through an iterative process with the Provincial Capital Commission to meet their Master Plan for Wascana Centre. The aesthetic is intended to be consistent with a working yard and reference agricultural architecture.

The Ministry of Saskbuilds and Procurement set Energy Efficiency as a priority for this building. The design team was challenged to deliver a design that beat the National Energy Code of Canada for Buildings 2017 by 25%. The final design exceeded this goal!




