## Luc Mullinder

**The Changing Climate of Emergency  
Response**

Luc Mullinder has been with the Canadian Red Cross for sixteen years, starting as a Saskatchewan Roughrider player ambassador for the work the CRC did supporting Healthy Youth Relationships in schools.

After retiring from the Canadian Football League (CFL) in 2013, Luc began his career with the Red Cross as a project manager in the former RespectED program. He later transitioned into philanthropy, where he led the Saskatchewan and Manitoba fundraising teams with a primary focus on corporate partnership development.

In 2020, Luc was appointed Vice President of Saskatchewan, where he led a strategic shift in how emergency response was approached in the province. Under his leadership, CRC-SK moved away from a provincially operated model and helped establish Emergency Response and Activation Agreements with Saskatchewan's First Nation Tribal Councils. This work reflected a commitment to walking alongside Indigenous communities in support of Nation-to-Nation emergency response and self-determined planning.

In 2024, Luc's Vice President role was expanded to include Manitoba and Nunavut.

Born in Auckland New Zealand, Luc's family originally emigrated to Canada in 1987. Growing up in Mississauga, ON, Luc attended Michigan State University on a full football scholarship and was eventually drafted 32nd overall in the 2004 Canadian Football League draft by the Saskatchewan Roughriders. Luc would go on to play professionally for nine years, winning a Grey Cup with the Riders in 2007.

Luc now lives in Regina, Saskatchewan with his wife, Mel, and two children. In his free time, he's still involved in football as a part-time CFL analyst on the football media side. He also loves golf despite being incredibly below average!
